Introduction	Introduce the topic of the thirteen colonies, highlighting the colony. What year was the colony founded?	
Foundation	Who founded the colony? Why was the colony founded? Who was in charge of governing the colony?	
Geography	Is the colony a Southern, Middle, or Northern colony? How did the geographical features dictate life in the colony?	
Population	Who lived in the colony? Where did they come from? Why did they settle there? What was life like for them?	
Colonial Cities	What were some major colonial cities or settlements? What were they known for? Are they still considered to be major cities today?	
Economy	What did the colonists do to make money? What were some of the major exports of the time?	
Hardships	What were some hardships (sickness, war, natives, food shortages, etc.) the colonists faced? What did the colonists do to overcome those challenges?	
Famous People	Write about at least two famous people from the colony along with information about why they were famous.	
Interesting Facts	What are some facts about the colony that you found interesting?	
Conclusion	Wrap up your research paper.
