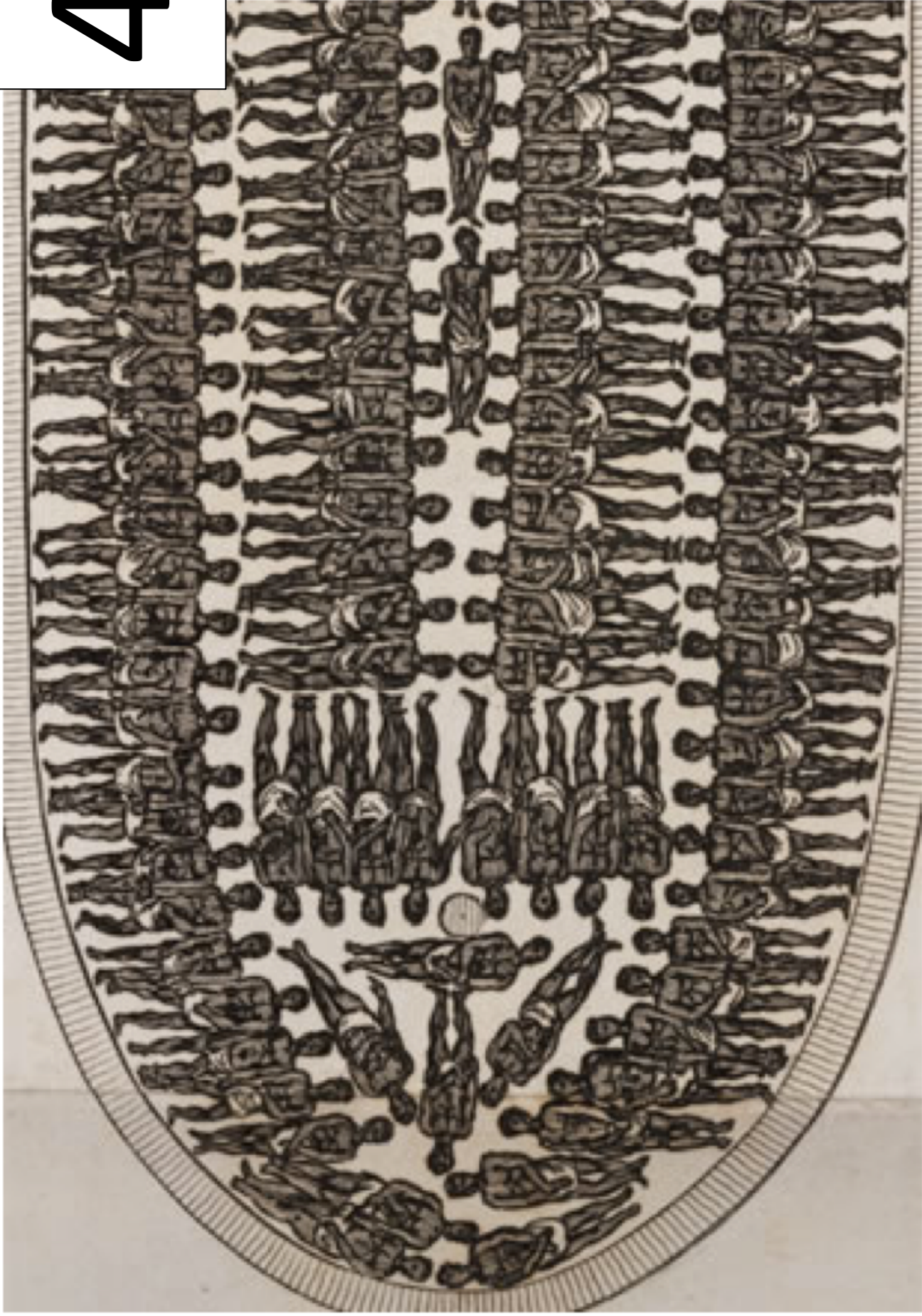

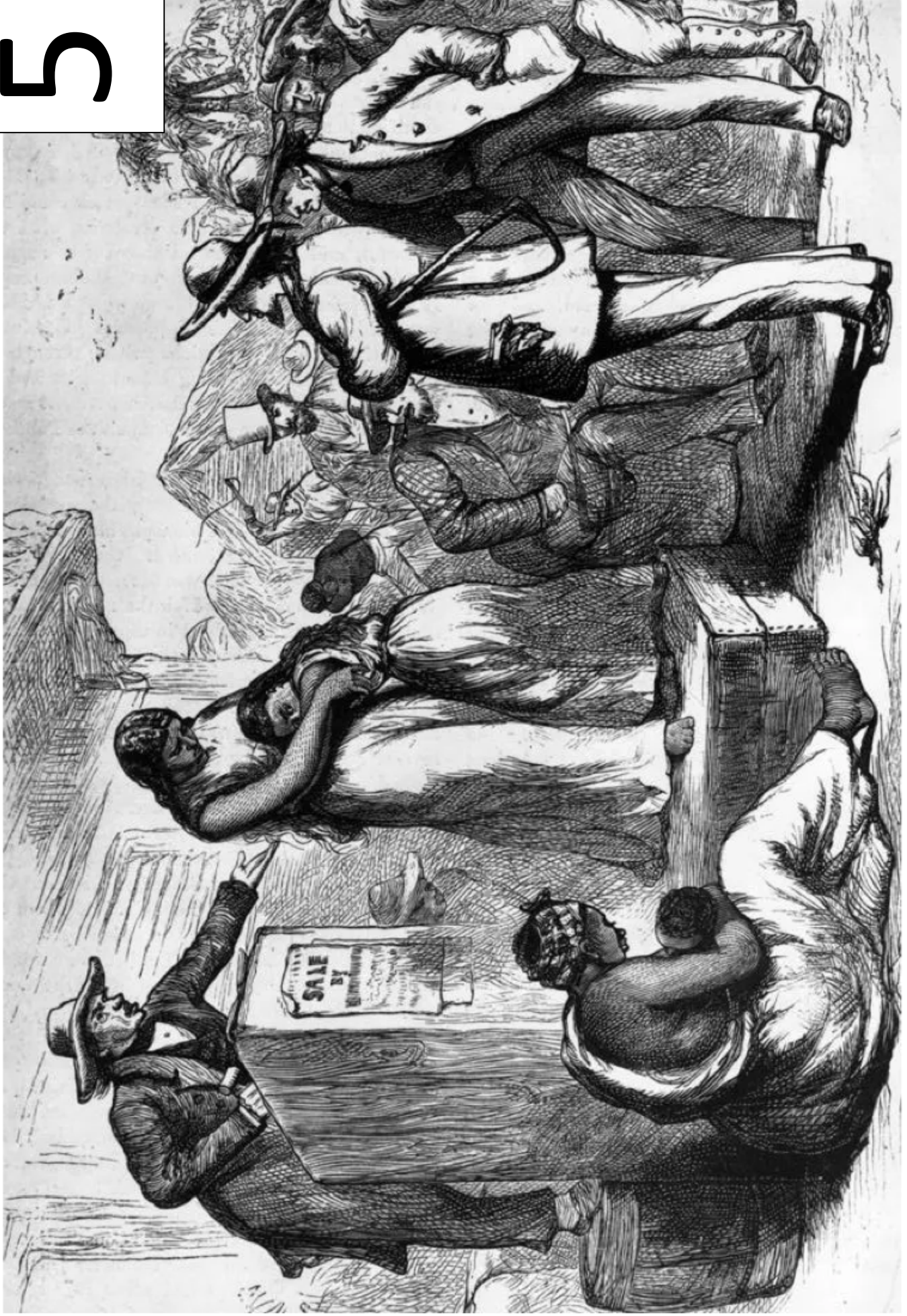

This diagram shows the inside of a slave ship that brought slaves from Africa up until 1807. Conditions were so awful that at one point, 1 out of every 5 slaves died during the journey. The passage from Africa to America took between 2 and 4 months.
